PRISCILLA

It is time to give you an update concerning Priscilla, my faithful wife, companion and supporter for the last 40 years here in Kenya.

She was discharged after a few days in hospital and all thought she would recover ‘in a few days’. But there was either a second stroke, or some ‘incident’ so that there was no improvement in her speech. So she returned to hospital for more days. She is now recuperating at son Jonathan’s home and slowly regaining her speech. She is on a blood thinner to seek to prevent any further blood clot, and has started a course of speech therapy.

Her next appointment with the neurologist is on December 8th and so she cannot travel at least until that time. I am therefore making plans to be with her in America in the next few weeks, and then we will take it day by day as the Lord providentially directs.

We are so thankful for your expressions of love and concern for Priscilla in particular.
