

'PRAY FOR KENYA' - APRIL 2022

24 Sunday Ministry today: (1) In Nairobi: DK takes up the SS on Eschatology and preaches in the morning service from 1st John 4. EA is down to preach in the afternoon service from Matthew 7:7-11. (2) MI is in **Kitale** to visit brother Teka and sister Martha and the brethren who fellowship at Teka's house.

25 Monday The annual Banner of Truth **Ministers' Conference** (UK) is being held over the next few days. Pray for the Lord's blessing on KU and the few hundred gathered to hear the word of God and to be empowered. [<https://banneroftruth.org/uk/store/events/uk-ministers-conference>]

26 Tuesday Maurice Isaiah Omondi continues to labour in **Kima**. Pray that Community Baptist Church where he serves would know God's preserving and enlarging blessings. They currently need to construct a small shed where the children can have their Sunday School hour. Please pray that the Lord would provide for this.

27 Wednesday Trinity Reformed Baptist Church **Meru** had the two men sent from Nairobi, Eric & Manases, set apart as the Elders/Pastors in March. Having been through the TPC and a few years in TBCN this is now their first charge. Meru is a bustling town with great opportunities.

28 Thursday During KUs visit in March a number of **older members** of TBCN had the opportunity to fellowship with him. Pray that these brethren who have made Christ beautiful in our eyes as they have remained faithful to the Lord and his church would be strengthened to remain this way even in their old age. Pray that the younger church members would learn from and serve these older members.

29 Friday (1) Isaiah Juma continues to labour in **Chwele**. Pray for him and the church there to be faithful and to know God's gracious blessings. (2) As TBCN membership grows in size, pray that the elders will wisely serve God's people and that the brethren will strive to be consistent in their devotion to the Lord.

30 Saturday Pokot, and other areas in the north of Kenya, have experienced severe drought. Pray that the Lord would bless efforts to provide relief food to them. Many have migrated into Uganda, and the plans for starting the Bible School in Kasei have had to be postponed.

3 Sunday Ministry today: Paul Gachungi concludes his Sunday school series on the Gospel & Acts. DK preaches in the morning and Paul in the afternoon. At 2 p.m. we hope to hear three testimonies from people who want to join the membership. Thank the Lord that almost monthly there are such new members.

4 Monday (1) **Tonny Karwa** continues to serve at Grace Baptist Church, Kisumu. The family has gone through a challenging time last month with Olivia needing an MRI/MRV, Tonny needing a series of heart tests, and their two children (Junior & Levin) being hospitalized with one (Junior) having an ENT surgery. Pray that in the midst of this difficult providence Tonny and Olivia will remain faithful and fruitful in the gospel. (2) Thank God for the recently concluded **Vacation Bible School** with up to 70 children and pray for parents to make the most of the school holidays to point their children to Christ.

14 Thursday TBCN's annual Easter conference – **Passion for Missions Conference** - starts tomorrow and ends on Saturday.
