It was such a good opportunity to witness to the saving grace of Christ that I completely forgot about the folder with all my addresses and left them on the plane! Thankfully everything is now digitalized and I had them both on my computer and flash-drive, so getting extra printed copies was easy.

Kisumu Reformed Family Conference

The Family Conference has been running for a number of years. I was invited specifically to strengthen the fellowship between the churches linked to Nairobi Trinity Baptist Church, and those linked to Grace Baptist Church Kisumu.

About 200 people were registered in attendance from various church in Kenya. Two things in particular struck me. First, this was a Family Conference with many children

and young people, yet there were 12 addresses on one theme. There is a hunger for serious preaching of the Word of God. Second, the singing of the great hymns of the faith, especially those that fitted with the theme, was with eagerness.

Barnabas and I sought to be expository in all that we said, using one particular verse or passage to explain the topic – Understanding the Church, Christ building the Church, You must be part of the church, Submit to the church, Be careful with the church, Maintain the unity of the church, and There is hope for the church. We pray that one fruit will be a close involvement in respective local churches.

On the Saturday I had the privilege of speaking to about 100 present and former students of the Wisdom Training Centre in Mumias, some distance north of Kisumu. The pastor and teacher here is Elly Achok (left), real brother to Barnabas (right), my co-speaker. Some years back they came out of a long-standing attachment to the Word of Faith movement and trained with us in Nairobi.
